The Regional Water Authority (RWA), a nonprofit corporation, provides water to almost 430,000 people in south central Connecticut. It takes four state-of-the-art surface water treatment plants, over 1,700 miles of underground pipes, 27,000 acres of watershed land, 110,000 drinking water tests per year, the safe operation of a myriad of equipment and a team of dedicated, skilled employees working 24/7 to produce and deliver abundant, reliable, high-quality water.

RWA consumers get this life-sustaining product delivered straight to their homes and businesses for less than a penny a gallon. The average family of four in the Greater New Haven area uses about 205 gallons of water a day and pays about \$57 per month¹. 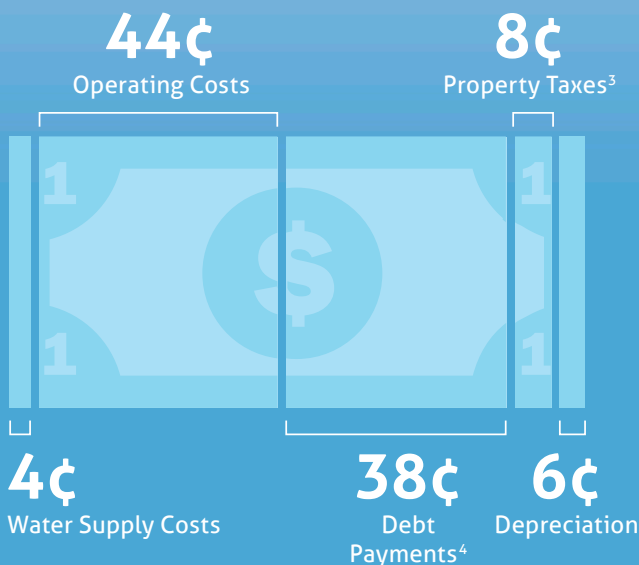

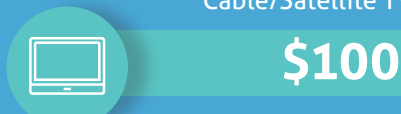
